
Progress as of 15th May, 2019

Alison Boarding House:

- All internal demolitions work and removal of debris - completed.
- Plastering work on internal perimeter walls in progress.
- Cleaning & painting work of steel columns and beams are in progress.
- Window sashes being repaired at contractor's workshop.
- Steel strengthening work for block work (upstairs) -70% completed.

New Commerce Block

- Excavation and leveling 70% complete.
- Retaining walls 40% complete.
- Concrete retaining wall foundation in progress.
- Column foundations 15% complete.
- Excavation for column foundations in progress.
- A total of more than 100 truck loads of excavated earth removed from site.
