As you will have gathered from our frequent News Releases and other social media postings, progress at the two construction sites has been remarkable over the last year, despite interruptions in April last and General elections in November. We are happy to announce that renovation of Alison House is complete, bar the installation of a Central Ventilation System , an intervention considered necessary recently by the Consultant Engineer and the Architect. The new Commerce Block (class rooms) is structurally near 60% done; completion expected by June this year. The A&OC is now poised to take on the third project viz, the New Science Block, for which preliminaries are already in hand.

We are delighted to announce that Old Boy donations (paid-up) have now surpassed Rs. 70 million!, and further pledges amounting to Rs. 50 million expected over the next two years. Our grateful thanks to all those old boys who have lent their shoulders to the wheel.




Project Expenditure




Site Visits
