

Re-Opening School on the 27th to 31st of July for Grade 11

Dear Parents of Grade 11 Students

Following the sudden closure of schools on the 10th of July we plan to re-open the school for Grade 11 and Grade 14 ONLY from the 27th to the 31st of July.

ONLY Grade 11 A, 11 B, 11 E and 11 H will come to school on Monday, the 27th while ONLY Grade 11 C, 11 D, 11 F, 11 G, and 11 I will come to school on Friday the 31st. The detailed timetable for these two days **will be posted on the MS Teams for English**.

As I informed you in my earlier letter, the Education Department of Central Province has organized an Assessment of Learning for the Grade 11 students. This assessment had to be postponed due to the sudden closure of schools and **will now be held on the 28th, 29th and 30th of July (Tuesday to Thursday)**.

The papers are prepared by the Department of Education and the Answer Scripts will be evaluated by the Teachers of another designated School. The schedule of the assessments and instructions about entry to school and the classrooms that will be used are given below.

ALL students should be present in school by 0745 on the 28th, 29th and 30th. Those who come early should sit in the College Hall until the examination rooms in the **Stopford Block** are opened at 0730.

We encourage the students – and the parents – to consider this assessment as a tool for understanding their current state of preparation for the examination. It is important that students develop the ability to take the responsibility for their own learning. Our teachers will work with students to identify and then correct any weakness in the basics of the subjects that are brought out by the assessments.

Instructions for the Assessments on the 28th, 29th and 30th of July

ALL the students of Grade 11 (All three mediums) are expected to come to school on the above-mentioned dates.

The Entry and Exit Point will be the **Junior School Main Gate on all days.**

The Gate will be open from 7:00 a.m. Students who come early should sit in the College Hall until the classrooms are opened. The Grade 11 students are expected to be present in time to settle down in the allocated classrooms.

The Assessments will be held IN THE STOPFORD BLOCK. The Classrooms will be arranged according to COVID 19 precautions with social distancing. Every student will be given an allocated desk and chair with his Admission Number for this purpose. Students should NOT use any other desk.

Students are expected to bring the necessary writing materials, water bottles and snacks. Kindly avoid sharing of food and writing materials.

Students will leave at 1:30 p.m.

Regular classes will be conducted on the 28th and 31st of July 2020 for the students of Grade 11 from 08:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. – IN THE FERNANDO BLOCK - as follows:

28th July 2020 – Grade 11 A, 11 B, 11 E and 11 H (Entry & Exit through Junior School Main Gate)

31st July 2020 – Grade 11 C, 11 D, 11 F, 11 G, and 11 I (Entry & Exit through Junior School Main Gate)
